Heritage

Château Tanunda was established in 1890 and is the site of some of the very first vines planted in the Barossa in the 1840s as well as the Valley's first winery. The Château is an Australian heritage icon whose grand buildings, magnificent gardens and prime vineyards are owned by the Geber family who continue a tradition of fine winemaking spanning three centuries.

Our Château Tanunda style is classic and refined, combining both traditional and modern winemaking techniques to make superb, handcrafted wines of complexity and intensity.

This Château Tanunda Dry Rosé is bursting with juicy strawberry and raspberry aromas leading to a lively palate full of red berry fruits and a cranberry lift on a crisp dry finish.
