



THE OLD COOPERAGE Barossa Grenache 2018

Heritage

The *Old Cooperage* celebrates the historic relationship between Chateau Tanunda and A.P. Johns Coopers. Since establishing the Chateau Tanunda Cooperage in 1889, four generations of the John family have worked in coopering in the Barossa and still provide barrels to our winery

Vineyard

For this limited release wine, we selected two hand-picked parcels of Grenache from Bethany and Eden Valley for the 2018 Old Cooperage Grenache.

Winemaking

The wine is handcrafted in small open fermenters with partial whole bunch fermentation, and basket pressed before 16 months maturation in seasoned French and American oak hogsheads. Bottled unfined.

Notes

Lifted aromas of cherry, raspberry, and liquorice are accompanied by spicy red berry fruits on the palate. The finish is long with fine-grained tannins from 16 months maturation in American and French oak barrels. 400 dozen produced.
