# THE CHÂTEAU SINGLE VINEYARD EDEN VALLEY CHARDONNAY 2021

#### Heritage

Château Tanunda was established in 1890 and is the site of some of the first vines planted in the Barossa in the 1840s as well as the Valley's first winery. The *Château* is privately owned by the Geber family who continue a tradition of fine winemaking spanning three centuries.

## Vineyard

The grapes for this Chardonnay are from select rows of our Eden Valley vineyard. The vines grow on deep clay loam contrast sandy loam soils on dark brown subsoil, enjoying extended ripening time to enhance the flavor and structure, thanks to the cooler climate at 400m altitude.

#### Winemaking

Hand-picked from select rows in our cool climate Eden Valley vineyard, the grapes are gently basket pressed (20% whole bunch) before fermentation in barrel.

Regular lees stirring and 8 months' maturation in new and seasoned French oak barriques give the wine added complexity.

### Notes

Delicate, classic aromas of white peach, opulent pear and toasty brioche all leading on to a sumptuous creamy palate of layer upon layer of lemon, citrus fruit and vanilla notes all balanced with a clean, mineral intensity that you always expect from this vineyard.

The seamless balance of understated oak never overstates, and whilst the current youthful exuberance of the fruit gives it an appealing freshness this wine will develop further complexity over the next 5+ years.

Pale straw with green and gold flecks, this opens with an appealing spiced nose. Good concentration with notes of orange rind, stonefruit and nutmeg, through to some lemon zest on the finish. Impressive length, this is lush and generous in both its flavour and style. Good acidity supports the wine. Should drink very well over the next four to five years. Like this a lot.

Pale colour. Attractive grapefruit white peach apricot aromas with hints of nougat/marzipan. Sourced from a single vineyard in the Eden Valley. Straw in the glass with aromas of juicy white peach, nectarine, melon and citrus fruits washed with soft spice and notes of clotted cream, vanillin oak, marzipan, white flowers and stone. Creamy, dry and long on the finish with fine, vivid acidity and a lengthy tail of spiced stone and citrus fruits and gentle oak spice.
