

## THE CHATEAU EDEN VALLEY CHARDONNAY 2016

### Heritage

Château Tanunda was established in 1890 and is the site of the very first vines planted in the Barossa in the 1840s. 'The Château' is a heritage icon, the grand buildings, magnificent gardens and vineyards are owned by the Geber family who continue the century old tradition of fine winemaking.

### Vineyard

Hand-picked from select rows in our high-altitude Eden Valley vineyard.

### Winemaking

The grapes are lightly basket pressed before the bunch wild fermentation. Takes place in barrel. Regular lees stirring and 12 months maturation in new and seasoned French oak barriques gives the wine added complexity.

### Tasting note

Aromas of citrus, pear and white peach lead to enticing fruit flavours on the palate. Crisp acidity, complex layering with a hint of nougat culminate in a long seamless finish.
