HERITAGE

Château Tanunda, Icon of the Barossa, was established in 1890 and is the site of some of Valley's earliest vines as well as its first winery. The Château is privately owned by the Geber family who continue a tradition of fine winemaking spanning three generations.

WINEMAKING

Since the Geber family took custodianship of Château Tanunda in 1998, the family have been setting aside certain wines from select vintages for fortification and maturation in the large format 'foudre' barrels at our Cellar Door. Visitors to the Château would be familiar with these 1290L to 2310L barrels of seasoned Swiss oak imported from Evelyne Geber's home country of Switzerland.

We are now proud to present this fortified Tawny style wine from a blend of those various vintages in this traditional 500ml bottle.

TASTING NOTE

This tawny shows intense flavours of raisins, prunes, orange peel cinnamon and nutty complexity with a long clean finish. Presented in its own individual gift box, it is a must for all lovers of Barossa fortified.
