

GRAND BAROSSA GRENACHE SHIRAZ MOURVÈDRE 2022

Heritage

Château Tanunda, Icon of the Barossa was established in 1890 and is the site of some of the Valley's earliest vines as well as its first winery. The Château is privately owned by the Geber family who continue a tradition of fine wine making spanning three centuries.

Vineyard

For our Grand Barossa wines, we select grapes grown throughout the Barossa and its myriad of sub-regions. It is this tapestry of 'terroirs' which enables us to create our classic and refined house style.

Winemaking

Destemmed and fermented in separate parcels, the individual wine varieties were matured 18 months in new and seasoned French oak before the final blend was crafted prior to bottling.

Tasting note

This exciting blend of Grenache, Shiraz and Mourvèdre displays ripe aromas of blackberry, black cherry and raspberry flavours followed by spicy, dark berry fruits and a hint of white pepper on the palate. The finish is long with fine grained tannins.

Awards

93 Points – Sam Kim, Wine Orbit

Sweetly ripe and perfumed, it's instantly appealing on the nose with dark cherry, plum, rich floral, olive and roasted hazelnut aromas, followed by a succulent palate offering supple texture and refined tannins. Generous, flavoursome and highly enjoyable. At its best: now to 2035.

91 Points – Stuart Knox, The Real Review

Deep and intense ruby red with purple glints into the rim. A rich nose of blueberry and raspberry with hints of ironstone underneath. There's weight, power, and drive throughout the wine, fruit is quite ripe but there's enough meaty complexity as a foil to it. A little warmth at the finish but there's good value here.

91 Points – Dave Brookes, Halliday Wine Companion

A blend of 56/26/18% grenache/shiraz/mourvèdre matured in French and American oak. Crimson with characters of plum, blackberry and dark cherry fruits cut with gingery spice, cola, earth and pressed flowers. Medium bodied, spicy and fruit pure with a bright line and medium-length finish.
