

GRAND BAROSSA GRENACHE SHIRAZ MOURVÈDRE 2023

Heritage

Château Tanunda, Icon of the Barossa was established in 1890 and is the site of some of the Valley's earliest vines as well as its first winery. The Château is privately owned by the Geber family who continue a tradition of fine wine making spanning three centuries.

Vineyard

For our Grand Barossa wines, we select grapes grown throughout the Barossa and its myriad of sub-regions. It is this tapestry of 'terroirs' which enables us to create our classic and refined house style.

Winemaking

Destemmed and fermented in separate parcels for 7 days with regular hand plunging. The individual varieties were matured 8 months in seasoned French and American oak before the final blend was crafted prior to bottling.

Tasting note

This exciting medium-bodied blend of Grenache, Shiraz and Mourvèdre displays ripe aromas of blackberry, black cherry, pomegranate, and raspberry followed by spicy, dark berry fruits and a hint of white pepper on the palate. The finish is long with fine grained tannins.

Awards

93 Points – Sam Kim, Wine Orbit

A delightfully comforting red; the inviting bouquet shows sweet cherry, raspberry, toasted nut and mixed spice aromas. The palate is equally attractive with supple mouthfeel backed by layers of fine tannins, making it silky and lingering. At its best: now to 2031.

92 Points – Ray Jordan, Wine Pilot

A wine that positively bursts with Barossa fruit. Plums, blackberry and cherry all burst from the nose with a subtle pepper and spice. The palate is soft and generous but well-held and controlled with a fine layer of oak and infused tannins. A polished and complete wine.

91 Points – James Suckling

This has a rich nose that brings to mind dark fruits as well as raspberries, dried herbs, a touch of rust and pepper. The medium- to full-bodied palate is fluid with soft, silky tannins and a round, juicy finish. Drink now. Screw cap.
