Heritage

Chateau Tanunda, Icon of the Barossa was established in 1890 and is the site of some of Valley's earliest vines as well as its first winery. The Chateau is privately owned by the Geber family who continue a tradition of fine winemaking spanning three generations.

Vineyard

For our Grand Barossa Shiraz we select grapes grown throughout the Barossa and its esteemed vineyards. It is this tapestry of "terroirs" which enables us to create our classic and refined style





















Winemaking

The Grand Barossa Limited Reserve displays Barossa Shiraz characters of rich dark berry fruits, plum, black forest cake and sweet spice. It has been handcrafted in small open fermenters and basket pressed before 15 months maturation in French and American oak barrels. By combining both traditional and modern wine making techniques, Chateau Tanunda are able to produce wines of complexity, depth and intensity.

Tasting note

Deep ruby red in colour, bursting with aromas of red berries, cherry with subtle undertones of vanilla oak. The palate is lush and dense, flavours of plum and cherry with gentle tannins and great length.
