Overview

We celebrate the lunar calendar of THE YEAR OF THE TIGER symbolising power, courage and confidence.

Heritage

Château Tanunda, Icon of the Barossa was established in 1890 and is the site of some of Valley's earliest vines as well as its first winery. The Château is privately owned by the Geber family who continue a tradition of fine winemaking spanning three generations.

Vinevard

For our Grand Barossa Shiraz we select grapes grown throughout the Barossa and its esteemed vineyards. It is this tapestry of "terroirs" which enables us to create our classic and refined style

Winemaking

The Grand Barossa Limited Reserve displays Barossa Shiraz characters of rich dark berry fruits, plum, black forest cake and sweet spice. It has been handcrafted in small open fermenters and basket pressed before 15 months maturation in French and American oak barrels. By combining both traditional and modern wine making techniques, Château Tanunda are able to produce wines of complexity, depth and intensity.

Tasting note

Lifted aromas of blackberry, plum and black pepper are accompanied by spicy, dark berry fruits on the palate. Although drinking well now this wine may be cellared for up to ten years from vintage.
