

## GRAND BAROSSA CHARDONNAY 2024

### Heritage

Château Tanunda was established in 1890 and is the site of some of the very first vines planted in the Barossa in the 1840s as well as the Valley's first winery. The Geber family proudly continue a tradition of fine winemaking spanning three centuries.

### Vineyard

From a selection of vineyards across the Barossa, the grapes are picked at optimal ripeness in the cool of night to preserve freshness and retain optimal acidity.

### Winemaking

Our house style is classic and refined, combining both traditional and modern winemaking techniques to make superb handcrafted wines of complexity and intensity.

### Tasting note

Exciting aromas of citrus fruits, melon and white peach lead to bright tropical fruit flavours on the palate with a refreshing acidity. On the finish there is a hint of vanilla and cashew nut from French oak barrel maturation.
