

GRAND BAROSSA DRY RIESLING 2025

Heritage

Château Tanunda, Icon of the Barossa was established in 1890 and is the site of some of Valley's earliest vines as well as its first winery. The Château is privately owned by the Geber family who continue a tradition of fine winemaking spanning three generations.

Grand Barossa Riesling grapes are selected from our estate vineyards on the Biscay soils of Tanunda and the deep sands of the Vine Vale sub-regions. Some of these vines are 100+ years in age, adding to the complexity and depth of flavour of this wine. This tapestry of 'terroirs' enables us to create our classic and refined house style.

Winemaking

Picked in the cool of the night to preserve freshness, we combine both traditional and modern winemaking techniques to make a handcrafted Riesling of complexity, depth and intensity.

Tasting note

Aromas of lemon and lime blossom leading to zesty citrus and stonefruit flavours on the palate with a crisp, delicate and refreshing finish. Although drinking beautifully now, this wine may be cellared for up to eight years from vintage.
