

HERITAGE RELEASE 'OLD VINE' SHIRAZ 2024

Heritage

The Heritage Release Old Vine Shiraz celebrates the world famous old vines of the Barossa exemplifying the quality and history of these unique Barossa old vines. The colourful front label is a celebration of the rich heritage of the Chateau with a version of one of the original Chateau Tanunda labels from the 1970s.

Vineyard

This special release wine comes from Barossa old Shiraz vineyards of at least 35 years of age in the Moppa (North) and Vine Vale (Central) regions of the Barossa. Their worthiness has been proven over many vintages, consistently producing fruit for wines of distinction and longevity.

Winemaking

The wine is handcrafted in small open fermenters and basket pressed before 15 months' maturation in French and American oak barrels. This wine is suitable for vegans and vegetarians.

Tasting note

This old vine Shiraz is full of soft, dark cherry fruit, black berries and mocha flavours with rich notes of dark chocolate and subtle oak. The palate is textured and layered, with the dark berry fruit aromas again coming to the fore framed by silky tannins. The palate has a long plush, elegant finish. Enjoy now or cellar carefully for up to 10 years.
